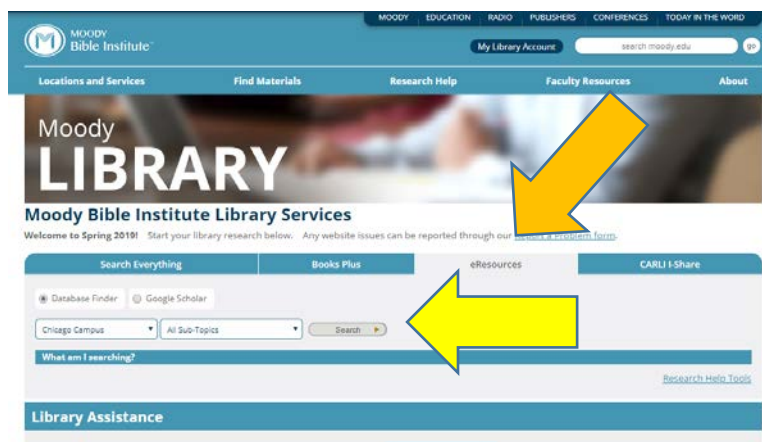


Digital Resources for students of world religions, etc.

Here are some helpful databases that provide information on non-Christian religions.

1. To access them directly, click the **eResources tab** on the home page, then click **Search**.

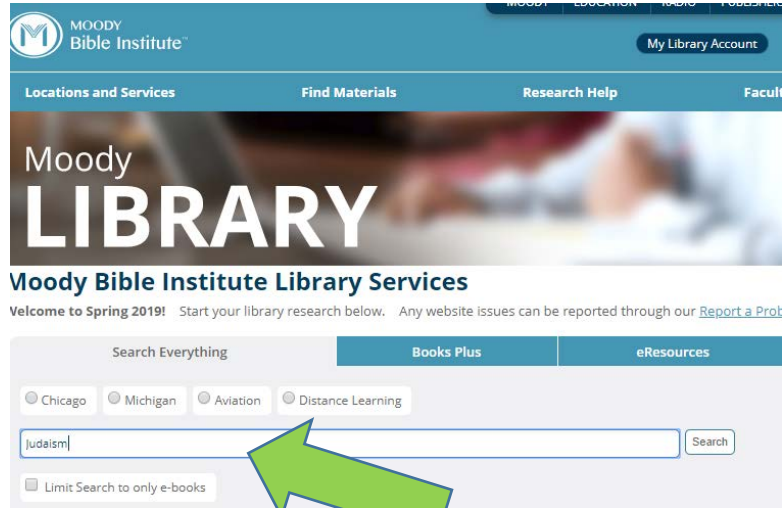
- [Academic Ebook Collection from EBSCO](#) : Over 170,000 e-books (unlimited user access). Click eBooks on the blue bar at the top of your screen, browse by category and select Religion, and search over 17,000 religion full-text ebooks.



- [Global Road Warrior](#) - A comprehensive country-by-country cultural database featuring in-depth information on 175+ countries. Designed for international studies, cross cultural studies, language studies, and studying abroad programs.
- [Oxford Handbooks Online - Religion, Psychology and Linguistics](#) - Go to Oxford Handbooks Online, and click Religion to access over 60 handbooks and over 2,200 articles.
- [Oxford Reference](#) – Click on any of the following titles: *The Oxford Dictionary of the Jewish Religion (2 ed.)*, *The Oxford Encyclopaedia of South Asian Christianity*, *The Oxford Encyclopedia of Religion in America*, *The Oxford Encyclopedia of the Islamic World*, *The Concise Oxford Dictionary of World Religions*
- [Oxford Research Encyclopedia of Religion](#) – Type in a search term, and click update. Find 115 articles on Islam, or 27 articles on atheism, or 133 articles on sacrifice, for example.
- [Oxford Scholarship Online: Religion](#) – Click on Religion, type in a search term in the Search with results box, and find 129 articles on Buddhism, or 24 articles on apologetics, or 10 articles on Daoism, or 6 articles on Confucius, for example. Click Clear All before starting a new search, then click on Religion and type in a new search term.
- [Oxford Very Short Introductions](#) – Hundreds of concise and original introductions to subjects in the disciplines of religion & philosophy. Type Religion in the search box, and find 62 books such as *Sikhism: A Very Short Introduction (2nd ed.)*, or *Paganism: A Very Short Introduction*, or *Kabbalah: A Very Short Introduction*
- [Routledge Handbooks Online – Religion](#) – Click Show All and Full access only to search books including *The Islamic World*, *The Handbook of Religions in Ancient Europe*, *The Handbook of Contemporary Animism*, *Routledge Handbook of Religions in Asia*, or *The Routledge Companion to Christianity in Africa*
- [World Religions Database](#) - Comprehensive guides to the world's major religions and spiritual traditions. Includes 100 complete texts that are sacred to the adherents of a religion, sacred music clips, videos, slideshows, maps, charts, and curriculum tools.

2. **Another way:** at the home page, type a search term in the **Search Everything box** to access virtually all our databases, ebooks, and print books. Refine your search results by using the limiters on the left column. Employ the brains of cataloging librarians by identifying then searching with the relevant subjects linked to your research topic.
